AVGCC Tournament of Aces Matchplay starts Feb 2

Second-ranked Razy Razon will battle Lando Alberto (7) while Vicente Go (3) will go up against Arturo Go (6). The last match will be a battle between No. 4 Mario Caballes and No. 5 Jun Pepito.

Aris Mata leads AVGCC January Golf winners

Aris Mata led the winners of the January Monthly Medal of Alta Vista Golf and Country Club after shooting a tournament -best gross score of two-under-par 70 last January 26 to bag the lowest gross honors for class A.



The 17-year-old Mata went up and down on the front nine making birdies on the 2nd and 3rd holes then hitting a bogey 5 on 4th and then double-bogeyed the par-4 5th hole. He went back to even-par with a birdie on the 7th, but bogeyed the par-3 8th before closing the first nine with a birdie to finish at 35 strokes.

In the back nine, he opened with a birdie on the tough hole number 10 and then made one more on the 14th to make the homestretch at two-under-par 35 for a gross 70 strokes.

The lowest net honors for class A went to Dennis Canoy, who fired a gross even-par-72 and finished with a net 64. Runner-up honors went to Dr. Jerry Uyheng with a net score of 65 also off a gross score of 72 strokes.

The lowest gross honors for class B went to Dr. Edwin Ho Lim with a five-over-par 77 strokes off nines of 39 and 38.

The lowest net plum went to Cristino Lim with a net score of 66 off a gross 81. He won the title after beating three others in the countback. Runner-up honors went to Charlie Gaite also with a net score of 66 besting Benjie Hortelano and Yasuyuki Kanai in the countback.

The lowest gross trophy for class C went to Toshiyuki Haga with 80 strokes off nines of 37 and 43.

Hideki Yamada bagged the lowest net honors for class C with 61 strokes off a gross 82. Runner-up honors went to Lawrence Chian with 65 strokes.

Masahisa Kawakami topped the seniors' division with a gross score of four-over-par 76 strokes off nines of 38 and 38.

IDENTIFICATION OF SMOKING AREAS IN THE CLUBHOUSE

DESIGNATED SMOKING CORNER

To comply with the provisions of Cebu City Ordinance 2241 or the Comprehensive Anti-Smoking Ordinance of the City of Cebu, which amends City Ordinance 2128, we are constrained to identify the proper areas where smoking shall be allowed in the clubhouse.

Thus, a temporary smoking lounge has ben set up outside of the Golfers' Bar and smoking shall not anymore be allowed at the Game Room or the veranda in the air conditioned areas of the Golfers' Bar.

Smoking will not also be allowed at the lobby near the ballroom or at the veranda of the ballroom. For this area, the smoking area shall be at the area near the guard station where pots will be put for the ashes and the cigarette butts.

At the Golfers' Lounge, smoking shall be allowed only at the areas near the windows. The View Lounge will be a No Smoking Area. The bridge and the tower have ben designated as a Smoking Area.

The Sports Pavilion and the lobby outside the Mancom Room and Admin Office are also No Smoking Areas as well as all air conditioned rooms of the clubhouse.
